Thank you in advance for taking the time to complete my 2014 Legislative Survey. As I make important votes on your behalf in Topeka, your input is crucial to my decision-making process.

I will be watching out for a number of tax changes, as well as education and agricultural issues during the session. Ending the mortgage registration tax and further reducing the income tax are primary targets and much of the budget will depend on how we address school finance.
